Sheep are essentially defenseless animals, so a shepherd carries a few tools to care for and protect his sheep. He has a rod for guarding and protecting, and he uses a staff with a little crook on the end to rescue the sheep when they get lost or get into trouble.

Unfortunately, we are like lost sheep in need of protection and direction. Thankfully, Jesus came to earth to be our *Good Shepherd*. He said, *I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.* ¹¹*I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.* (John 10:10b-11, NKJV)

God wants to direct and protect you, and He uses tools to do that. *If you follow Him, Jesus will lead you.* Jesus is not going to push you through life. He gets in front of you and essentially says, *"Watch how I do it. Look where I go."* John 10:4 says, *And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.*

If you bring your hurts to Him, Jesus is compassionate. Matthew 9:36 says, *But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.* The original Greek text is that Jesus hurt deeply for the people in the crowd and wanted to help them.

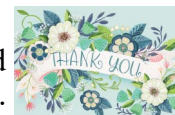
